Children in Year 2 visiting the SS Great Britain on Wednesday to enhance their history topic on Brunel.



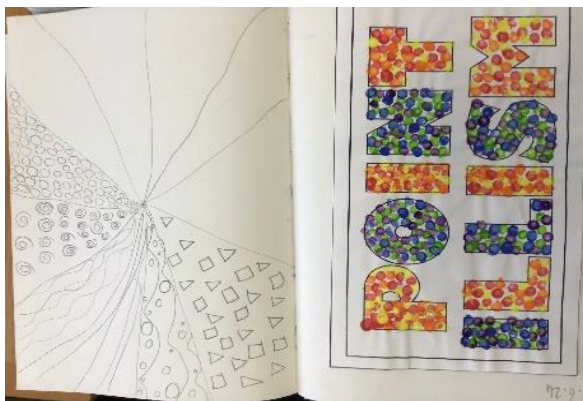
### Quad Kids
